The Organ Project UPDATE! · We're entering the final weeks of the pledge drive for our organ pipes! We're thankful to those who have submitted pledge cards to support this initiative, including a generous \$60,000 match! Currently we are sitting at 116 pledges for a total of \$143,005. Since the match was announced, we received 4 additional pledges for a total of \$5040. After the match, we have a remaining \$119,254.70 to reach the end goal of \$272,339.17 to create a hybrid organ as recommended by the organ committee. Once that pledged goal is achieved, we will move forward in collecting these pledged funds. This process will take place in December with all funds being received by December 31.
