Practicing the Ministry of Presence Breath Prayer for Presence: breathe in 'Lord help me to be present' breathe out 'for in silence there is healing.'

Deep Listening Lectio Divina with Lament Psalms: Meditate on Psalm 13, 22, or 88, listening for how God meets people in suffering.

Practicing Empathy Journaling from the Perspective of the Suffering: Write a prayer or reflection as if you were someone experiencing deep pain, helping cultivate compassion.

Waiting with God in the Uncomfortable Silence and Stillness Practice: Set a timer for 5-10 minutes and sit in silence before God, resisting the urge to rush to solutions.

The "fat" in Fat Tuesday refers to the practice of using up rich foods like eggs and butter in dishes like pancakes before Lenten restrictions on such items begin.
