Examen with Scripture. Grow in awareness of God's presence and direction.

- When today did I walk in God's light?

- When did I feel lost or unsure?

Scripture Meditation. Attune your heart to God's personal guidance.

- Slowly read one verse or passage.

- Let key words stand out.

- Reflect: What is God saying to you?

Silence & Solitude Make space to receive light from God's Word.

- Sit quietly with a verse.

- Listen instead of analyzing.

Prayer Walk Embody the metaphor—Scripture as a literal and spiritual guide.

- Walk slowly while repeating Psalm 119:105 or another verse.

- Let the Word guide your steps.

Sharing the Word Multiply the light—help illuminate someone else's path.

- Mentor, Teach, or Read with Others.

- God's Word is meant for you to light the way for others.
