Pastors Jon Larson & Amelia Houdek would love to connect with you, say hello.

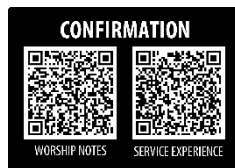
Listening devices are available at the Welcome Desk.
