Spiritual Practices

- 1. Breath Prayer (Sacred Pauses)
- Breathe in slowly...Holy Spirit.... Breathe out...Awaken my sense of awe
- Why it helps: Slows us down and attunes us to the Spirit's presence in the present moment—where wonder often hides.
- 2. Nature Walks (Creation Wonder Walks)
- Take a slow walk with the sole intention of observing the details of God's creation—colors, sounds, textures, patterns.
- Why it helps: Engaging our senses with the beauty of creation reconnects us with the Creator and evokes childlike awe.
- 3. Lectio Divina (Sacred Reading) with Wonder Focus
- Choose a short passage (like Acts 2 or Psalm 8). Read it slowly 3–4 times, asking each time, "What is stirring awe in me here?"
- Why it helps: Opens our hearts to the mystery of God's Word—*not just for knowledge but encounter.*
- 4. Wonder Journal
- Keep a small notebook where you jot down moments of surprise, beauty, or mystery. Title it: *Today I Was Amazed By...*
- Why it helps: Encourages a daily posture of attention and helps us track how the Spirit whispers awe into our lives.
